


UK & Ireland SAP Contractors Survey 2024

THE RESULTS

Here are the results of the biggest UK&I survey of SAP contractors ever to be undertaken. Hundreds of contractors had their say - and we'll be using this data to educate SAP employers on contractor preferences, trends, rates and needs.







Introduction

The SAP contractor community are critical to the success of business transformation programmes. But because they're part of the temporary workforce, their voices often aren't heard in the boardrooms of the businesses that need them.

This report aims to change that.

After surveying hundreds of SAP contractors across the UK & Ireland, we now have substantial data on:


- How much contractors are paid
- Their preferred working patterns
- What would make them likely to accept or reject a role
- What makes them stick around for the duration of the project

We will be sharing this data with SAP employers across the UK & Ireland - but it may also prove useful for you to share directly with your own hiring manager.

What level do you usually operate at?





Where do you live?





Which industry do you specialise in (if any)?





What is your gender?





In your last role, what currency were you paid in?





What was/is your day rate?





In your last role, what was your position's IR35 determination?





If **inside** IR35, would you leave/have left the role for a position that is/was **outside** IR35?





What programme environment are/were you working in?





What is/was your working pattern?





Did you have multiple contract offers when you accepted your last position?





How did you get your current or most recent role?





30.6%

Working with a specialist SAP recruitment agency is the most popular way for contractors to find new projects (30.6%), closely followed by using their own network (28.9%). This far outranks contact from in-house teams (8.9%) LinkedIn job postings (8.2%) and responding to adverts (5.2%).







What is the **average duration** of your SAP assignments, including contract extensions?







At what point before you get a confirmed extension do you look at other opportunities in the market?












57.9%
